* Student who resides temporarily outside his/her county * Voter or voter's spouse who has surgery/hospitalization scheduled during Early voting and Election Day *Voter who is a resident of KY covered by KRS 117A.010 *Uniformed service member who finds out they will be confined to a military base during Early Voting and Election Day & is not eligible for a mail in ballot. *In last trimester of pregnancy *Voter who temporarily resides outside the state but still eligible to vote in KY *Person who due to age, disability or illness will be unable to attend
